Details	<p>Established and emerging local artists are invited to submit their 3D work in any medium that is suitable for outdoor public display.</p> <p>This is a great opportunity for artists to get paid to exhibit their work in an outdoor context.</p> <p>The Lyme Regis Sculpture Trail is located across the Langmoor and Lister gardens in the heart of the stunning Jurassic coastal town. Perched above the beach, with far-reaching views to the famous Cobb and coastline beyond, these public gardens provide a perfect outdoor gallery amongst the woodland, lawns and flower borders.</p> <p>The sculpture trail receives thousands of visitors throughout the year and is managed by The Arts Development Company with the support of the Lyme Regis Town Council.</p> <p>Artists will be selected by the team at The Arts Development Company, who are looking to represent a cross-section of the visual arts and to encompass different materials and style.</p>

Sales	<p>If an artist sells their work which is exhibited in Langmoor and Lister Gardens, The Arts Development Company will take 25% commission fee, which will be put towards developing the trail.</p>
